

# PAPI FACT SHEET

## THE VIET NAM PROVINCIAL GOVERNANCE AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION PERFORMANCE INDEX (PAPI)

is the country's largest, annual, citizen-centric, nationwide policy monitoring tool. PAPI captures citizens' experiences and perceptions to benchmark the performance and quality of policy implementation and service delivery of all 63 provincial governments in Viet Nam, and to advocate for effective and responsive governance. Since its inception 12 years ago, PAPI has collected the views of **146,233** randomly selected citizens regarding the country's performance in governance and public administration, based on their direct interactions with local governments.

### HIGHLIGHTED ACHIEVEMENTS (2009 – 2020)

#### 63 provinces

convened PAPI diagnostic workshops to analyze citizens' feedback on PAPI governance areas.

#### 62 provincial governments

issued action plans, resolutions and directives to institutionalize their commitments to improving local governments' performance.

#### PAPI findings

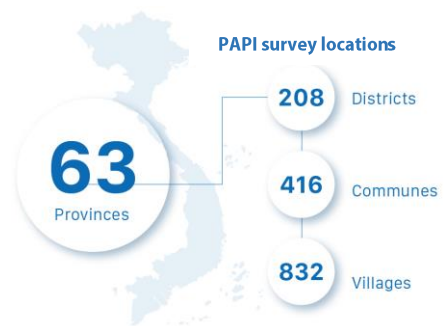

- Enhanced sharing, coordination and acceleration of best practices within and among provincial governments.

## WHY PAPI MATTERS?

Citizens are at the heart of Viet Nam's development. As 'end users' of public administration and public services they are fully capable of assessing the performance of the State and local authorities and supporting the State in establishing a State that is "of the people, by the people and for the people." Therefore, PAPI aims to generate information that can improve the performance of local governments in meeting their citizens' needs by: (i) enabling citizens to benchmark their local government's performance and advocate for improvement; and (ii) creating constructive competition and promoting learning among local authorities.
