TRAINING ROADMAP 2023 - 2025





Timeline

- The program lasts for 3 years (2023 – 2025)
- Each year, trainees will gather for 3 sessions, each of which is 2-3 days at most
- Between the training sessions, there are about 1-2 months for exercises.





Expectation

- Training 80 candidates in 3 years.
- The trainees are expected to run for election at all levels.
The target is set as below:
 - 03 candidates for the National Assembly deputies;
 - 25 candidates for People's Council deputies at all levels;





Training

- In-person training at the locality where the most trainees are based;
- Online training in case of pandemic outbreak;
- Training facility and materials are accessible to all trainees (soft copy, translation of sign language...);
- Support is available if requested.





Training content

- Knowledge equipped:
 - Legal system in Vietnam;
 - International treaties to which Vietnam has acceded;
 - Political system in Vietnam;
 - Election process;





Training content

- Powers and obligations of elected deputies:
 - The rights of persons with disabilities (PWDs) are recognized in the national and international laws;
 - The importance of promoting the political participation of PwDs;
 - Movement of PwDs at home country and abroad.





Training content

- Skills equipped:
 - Communicate with voters;
 - Regularly, quickly, and accurately study and update knowledge;
 - Advocate policies to ensure the rights of people with disabilities and vulnerable groups;
 - Consultancy;





Training content

- Skills equipped:
 - Advocacy and negotiation;
 - Media interaction;
 - Voter meeting and presentation;
 - Policy evaluation.
